To: Master, Ship-owners, Operators, Company Security Officers, Ship Security Officers and Recognized Security Organizations (RSO's) of Panamanian Flagged Vessel.

Subject: Restricted Vessels List.

1. The Panama Maritime Authority as part of its actions to improve the performance of our fleet and complying with its commitment to collaborate with the United Nations, has implemented the “Restricted Vessels List”, which is composed by three parts:

A. Vessels that have been deleted from the Panama Ship Registry, as a result of investigations that have shown links to the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea (DPR K)

B. Vessels included by any Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs) as Paris, Tokyo, Indian Ocean, Black Sea, into their underperformance or banned lists.

C. Flag Administrations that have been classified with a low performance or with a Very High Detention Index Level, according to United State Coast Guard and any Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs) as Paris, Tokyo, Indian Ocean, Black Sea, annual report 2016.

2. The purpose of this list is to inform interested parties, about the ships that our Administration has detected as participating in activities that are prohibited by the UN sanctions regime, and those ships that are subject to a previous technical analysis as part of our “due diligence” for the authorization of a new registry.

3. This list will be available at www.segumar.com, inside the tab “Restricted Vessels List” on the left hand side column.

4. We encourage all interested parties to be aware of the content of this list, as it gets updated periodically with the purpose to avoid contact of any nature, by virtue of the situation explained in this circular.
