Dear Exclusive Surveyors

The purpose of this letter is to inform that in search of continuous improvement of the Quality system and for **reasons of refreshment of knowledge** and we recently received frequent documents concerning the issuance of **REVALIDATION CERTIFICATES** outside the periods established in **procedure P-S-02 and MMC 156 5.3** which says:

5.3.31.5 In the event that a **CERTIFICATE LOSES ITS VALIDITY** due to a delay in the periodic, intermediate or annual inspection, as the case may be, or the inspection of the exterior of the live work of the ship, **they have not been carried out within the terms stipulated in the pertinent rule or article, it may be considered to request authorization from the Administration to issue a Conditional Certificate** in accordance with paragraph 5.4 of this procedure, as a transitory measure until the corresponding survey is carried out outside the window, it should not more than 3 months have elapsed since the closing of the corresponding window; in order to carry out the revalidation examination, which in such circumstances, would have to meet all the requirements of the examination that was not carried out and should be as complete and strict as required by the initial examination.

It will be necessary for the Surveyor on board to note:
